As convenor for the day sometimes the whole process can become quite overwhelming but when it all comes together and is appreciated it is definitely worthwhile – thank you Nira xo



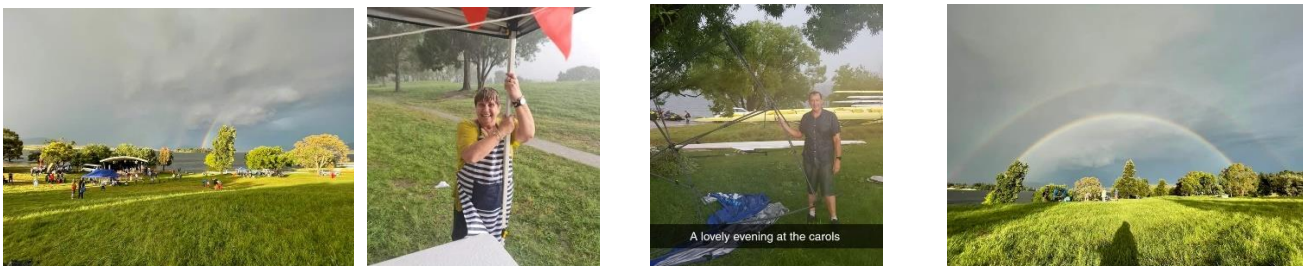
Next Dinner Meeting is Wednesday 9 Feb at the LJ Hotel at 6.30pm for 7pm start.
